OAK FAIR - TRAVEL AND PARKING

The nearest train station is Sherborne, to view timetables and book tickets please visit www.nationalrail.co.uk. You will need to get a taxi from the station. There is no public transport directly to Stock Gaylard as we are very rural.

Parking:

We have several areas including disabled parking, if you require disabled parking please let the attendants know when you arrive. All parking areas are monitored throughout both days by the team from Bradsons.
